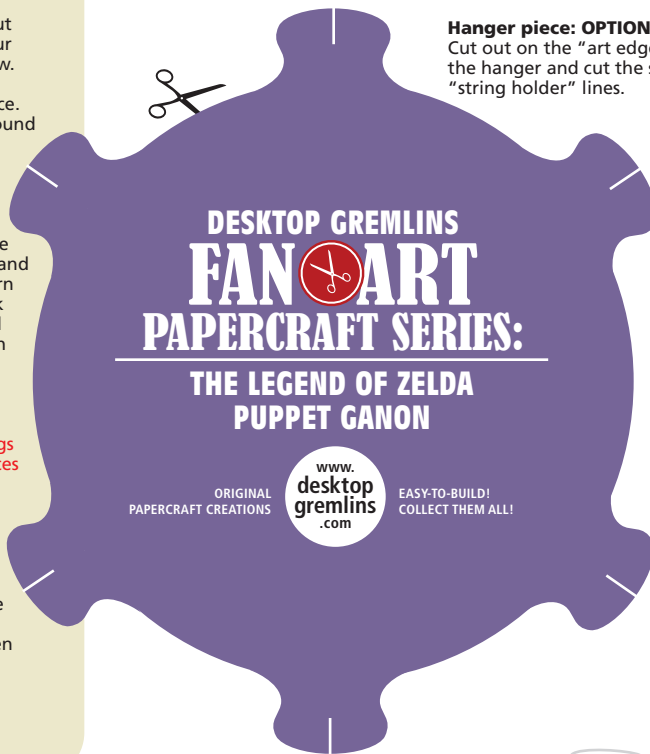


# LADIES AND GENTLEMAN! PRESENTING: ASTOUNDING! EASY-TO-BUILD THRILLING! MYSTERIOUS! PAPER SCULPTURES

**LOOK!** You can have a Desktop Gremlin sitting on your desk in just a few short minutes! Print this page on **glossy photo paper** (for best results) and grab a pair of scissors!



**INSTRUCTIONS** Trim out the 2 pieces that form your gremlin as indicated below. Don't forget to cut the assembly slots in each piece. Gently **CURVE** the foreground piece and secure onto the background piece by sliding the two vertical **GREEN** slots into each other. Then get 5 pieces of white string and tie one to each wrist, each ankle and the tail. A piece of red yarn should be tied to the neck stump on the background piece. You can then attach the strings to a fixture in your room.



**Hanger piece: OPTIONAL** Cut out on the "art edge" of the hanger and cut the six white "string holder" lines.

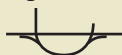

**Top view when foreground and background are secured together:**

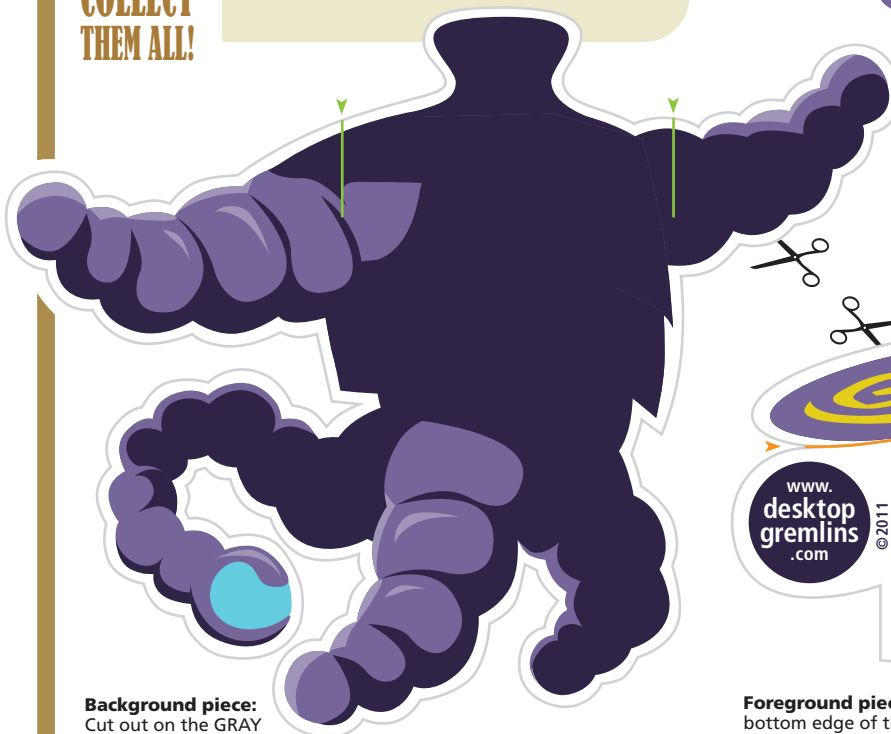


**CAUTION:** Do not attach this papercraft or its strings to any fixture that produces heat (such as a lamp).

If you wish, you can use the optional hanger piece (see right) to slide strings into white slots to fine tune tension, then tie off around each hanger knob. This hanger can then be mounted to a bulletin board, ceiling or the underside of a shelf.



**COLLECT THEM ALL!**



**Background piece:** Cut out on the GRAY line Don't forget to cut the green assembly slots.



**Foreground piece:** Cut out on the GRAY lines except for the bottom edge of the waist (which you will cut right on the art edge.) Don't forget to cut the green assembly slots and the orange lines near shoulders. The "shoulder armor" will overlap the background piece shoulders.
